



Things to Bring Space Academy for Educators Summer 2011



You will be staying in Charger Village at the University of Alabama in Huntsville (UAH). The address is 601 John Wright Drive NW, Huntsville, AL 35805. The phone is 256-824-5120. That number is for the Resident Assistant desk.

The dorms are set up in suite style, with each person having their own sleeping room, sharing a bath with one other person, and sharing a common area with three other people. The suites are not co-ed. The common area of the suite has a refrigerator and a microwave. Bed linens are provided, however, you might want to bring a pillow or towel from home.

Dress for the program is casual. Slacks or shorts are appropriate. You may want to dress in layers, as some of the classrooms may be cold, while the outside temperature will be very hot. You will also need comfortable walking shoes.

For the Aviation Challenge Water Activities you will be hanging from a parachute harness and you will want the extra fabric of long shorts. Even if you are not a swimmer, please bring swimming clothes. You can choose not to participate; however, this is the only place in the world where this type of simulation is available.

Females - one piece, conservative suit, with a pair of water proof shorts and a beach towel

Males - long trunks/ short like suit (not Speedo type) and a beach towel

Other things to bring:

Closed Toed/Closed Heeled SHOES for Space Camp simulations

Umbrella/ Rain gear /Sunscreen/ Hat/ Bug Spray

Camera, extra batteries, discs

Alarm clock

Snacks/ Coffee machine (there is not one at the dorm)

Clothes hangers

Cell phone (there are no phones in the rooms or pay phones at the dorm)

Toiletry items (deodorant, toothbrush, shampoo, hair dryer, medications, etc)

Money (to take a cab to Wal-Mart, as there are none within walking distance)

You will be sleeping on dorm beds, you might want to bring a foam mattress pad or you can purchase one at a local store when you get here.

There is no public wireless location for your computer on campus. UAH is working on this and we hope to offer wireless to you by the time you arrive.

If you are traveling by air, please remember to bring a change of clothes and a toothbrush in your carry-on luggage.
