

University Credit

Space Academy for Educators Bringing STEM to the K-12 Classroom is a three – semester-hour, graduate-level course that awards a letter grade upon completion. The cost is \$225.00.

The education departments of the U.S. Space & Rocket Center and The University of Colorado at Colorado Springs have designed this course as an in-service program of content workshops, activities, and other experiences related to space science, math, science, technology, social studies and reading for K-12 educators.

Attached is information how to register for this course. If any of the participants who want the credit and are non U.S. Citizens, they will need to submit a copy of their Visa (or other documentation for being in the country).

To register for classes at UCCS go to: **(You will not be able to sign up until the Spring, please check back in April & May for the website. We will post the website as soon as we receive information from UCCS)**

Two weeks after your return home from Space Academy for Educators you are required to write and submit a **reflection paper**. This paper should be based upon what you have personally learned as a result of participation in this program and ways in which you plan to implement your experiences in an interdisciplinary format in your classroom.

The content of your paper should relate to the space science topics, mathematics, and themes that you will incorporate in your classroom during this coming year. Reflections on your experiences here, what you have learned, and what you feel you still need to learn, should be included.

Your final *grade* for attending Space Academy for Educators will be based on your attendance, and the quality of your reflection paper. (Information on how the paper will be scored will be provided.) To receive a C or better, full attendance and submission of the reflection paper are required.

Once you have completed your course, you can use the student online center to access your grades and order your transcripts
