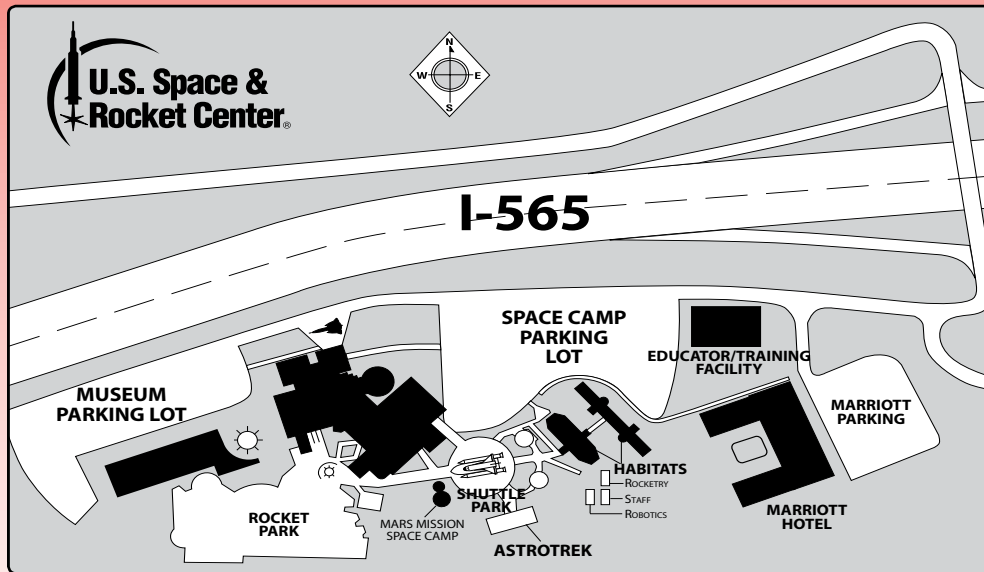


PARKING PROCEDURES

When you arrive, please proceed to the Main Museum Parking Lot (see map below).

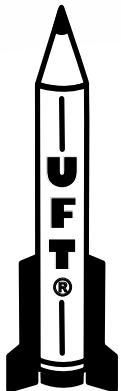

COUNTDOWN PREPARATIONS

Only the group leader may make changes to this reservation. We will not accept calls from additional parties concerning this reservation.

10 DAYS AFTER MAKING YOUR RESERVATION:

- Your non-refundable deposit of \$25 is due (this is deducted from your balance)
- Send only one form of payment for your deposit (Money Order, Check or Credit Card only)
- Purchase Orders will not be accepted as payment

T-MINUS 3 WEEKS PRIOR TO ARRIVAL:

- Contact us to confirm your date, IMAX® movie (if reserved), receipt of deposit, and contact information
- Please let us know if there are any physical or dietary needs for any person in your group

T-MINUS 5 BUSINESS DAYS PRIOR TO ARRIVAL:

- Call or fax final reservation numbers (additional guests upon arrival will be charged full price and are not guaranteed the same activity schedule as the group)
- If reserved, box lunches and IMAX movies must be cancelled 5 business days prior to reservation date (No refunds are available after this point)
- Verify arrival time and parking location for your group
- If the reservation is not confirmed 5 business days prior to arrival, it *may* be subject to cancellation

Weather Policy:

In case of inclement or cold weather, the outdoor/Rocket Park Simulators may not be operating

T-MINUS 0 DAYS: ARRIVAL PROCEDURES

Before arriving at the US Space & Rocket Center, please have the following:

- Correct count of children and adults in your group
- Single payment for the entire group (P.O.'s are not accepted)

Please arrive at your scheduled check-in time. (NOTE: The U.S. Space & Rocket Center is in the Central Time Zone)

- If you anticipate a late arrival call 256-721-7114 (No refunds will be issued for missed activities)
- See parking procedures on the following page

Please leave students on the bus while the Group Leader checks in:

- Bring your final payment (single payment: cash, check or credit card only; no purchase orders or coupons)
- Receive activity schedule
- Collect wristbands and distribute them to all members of the group

For everyone to get the best field trip experience students should leave the following devices at home, on the bus or with a chaperone:

- Digital Music Players (Ipod, Zune, Yep, etc)
- Portable Game Devices (Nintendo DS, Play Station Portable, etc.)
- Cell Phones
- CD Players
- Radios
- Wheelies (shoes with wheels/casters in the heels or soles)

Cameras and Video Cameras are encouraged

PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

- Time to enjoy the simulators and participate in all activities that are open to the public (Space Camp and Astrotrek Simulators are not included)

Simulations Policy: The following policies are in place for the safety of our guests.

Space Shot: 54 inches tall or taller G-Force: 48 inches tall or taller

Mars Simulator: 36 inches tall or taller Lunar Lander: No more than 48 inches tall

Mars Climbing Wall: You must weigh at least 50 lbs and wear closed-toe shoes
